



Main Rules & Policies

The Speed Limit in the park is only 8 km/hour / Quiet hours 10:00 PM to 9:00 AM daily

Our Camping Season: May 1 - September 30

GATE CARDS

- **The Gate card is for YOUR use only** and is not to be given or shared with anyone else. Deposit of \$25/card, which is fully refundable when the card is returned in **good condition** & functional.

VEHICLES

- Only one vehicle per site is included with your site. **DO NOT** block the roads or park in vacant sites at any time.

ELECTRIC (HYDRO) SERVICES

- Tampering with hydro meters or hydro breakers may result in immediate removal from the campground and/or prosecution. **PLEASE DO NOT USE ANY OTHER ELECTRICAL OUTLET OTHER THAN THE ONE ASSIGNED TO YOUR SITE!**

VISITORS

- Transient Campers are **not** allowed visitors. (Seasonal Campers, please see additional Rules & Policies)

CHILDREN

- Children are to be under adult supervision at all times. Playground equipment is not to be used after dark. Bicycle riding is permitted on park roads only and is not permitted after dusk. Helmets **MUST BE** worn by all riders under 16 years of age for their own safety, and are suggested for those 17 and older. Children are to be on their own sites after dusk (unless there is a scheduled event)

PETS

- A **maximum of 2 Pets** are allowed per site. Pets must be on leash at all times, never leave pets unattended. Put waste into a tied plastic bag, deposit into appropriate garbage containers (**DO NOT** put in any bathroom garbage or down toilets) We do not allow pets that are unfriendly or aggressive towards adults, children, or other pets. Kennel cages or fenced dog runs are not permitted on your site. We require your pet to be licensed and have record of vaccines.

ALCOHOL USE

- Keep all alcohol on your site. Drink in moderation as unruly behaviour will not be tolerated. *Although, we do not restrict alcohol use, we do ask that you drink responsibly, so it does not lead to any issues.*

GARBAGE & RECYCLING

- The Garbage dumpster is under video surveillance & located at the front entrance. The dumpster is for household garbage only. Any large items are not allowed in or beside the dumpster. Recycling is encouraged to be taken home. We will advise campers when we are doing a run to the landfill for larger items (additional fees may be required).

CAMPFIRES

- Campfires are allowed in existing fire pits only and must be contained to the size of the fire pit. Do not move firepits without permission. Campfires must be attended to and be extinguished before you leave or retire for the evening.
- Firewood is available for purchase from the store. **No Outside Firewood is Allowed**; this is for the protection of the local ecosystem.

GOLF CARTS, ATVs & BOATS

• Boats, Golf carts, dirt bikes and ATVs are **NOT** allowed. Utility trailers are not allowed without Management approval in advance, nor for any extended period of time.

OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOL

- Pool Hours are posted. All children 15 years or under must be supervised in the pool.
- Smoking, food, alcohol, or other open beverage containers are not permitted in the pool enclosure.
- Pool phone is for emergency use only. First Aid supplies are available at pool.
- The pool may be closed due to inclement weather or at any time subject to our discretion.
- We reserve the right to refuse admittance to the pool for health and/or safety reasons.

COMMUNICATIONS, SOCIAL MEDIA ETIQUETTE

• We use Email as our main method of communication. At least one personal email address is to be provided to us for this purpose.

• We have a Website as well as a Facebook page to communicate general park information, post pictures, post events, and highlight park information. No account or sensitive information is to be discussed online. We ask for your attitude to remain positive and respectful when using these outlets. Any rude or disrespectful comments will be removed. Any violation of any federal, provincial, or municipal laws by a camper, or their guests will likely result in reservation being cancelled without refund.
